REMOTE WORKER QUICK REFERENCE

The Air Force District of Washington (AFDW) is a direct reporting unit to the Department of the Air Force, the office of the Chief of Staff of the Air Force. AFDW serves as the Air Force service component for coordination purposes to Joint Task Force-National Capital Region (JTF-NCR).

As one of USAF's three direct reporting units, AFDW executes Air Force operations and supports Joint Force and Inter-Agency operations in the NCR while providing superior support to combatant commanders and Air Force elements worldwide. AFDW is the parent command to the 316th Wing, the 11th Wing, and 844th Communications Group.

Points of Contact

While assigned to AFDW as a remote worker your primary points of contact for AFDW services are your supervisor and the AFDW Telework Coordinator.

The telework coordinator can assist with connecting you to the resources at your nearest DAF installation.

- The Help Desk will attempt to resolve the issue remotely.
- If they are unable to resolve your issue remotely, you may have to go to the closest Air Force/Space Force Base for support. The Help Desk will open an AFNET ticket on your behalf assigned to that base for service.
- For additional help determining the nearest base or supportable agency, please contact the AFDW Telework Coordinate (Meghan Govin, AFDW/A1C)
- The assigned Base Comm Focal Point (CFP) in your local area will contact you to arrange a visit. The AFNCR IT Services team will standby to assist remotely, and provide additional information as required.
- In some cases you may need to replace an existing asset. When this is necessary, the IT Services Team will coordinate with your organization to take possession of the asset and issue a replacement.
