Back to School Safety

Bus Riders

- 1. Teach children the proper way to get on and off the bus
- 2. Line up 6 feet away from the curb as the bus approaches
- 3. If seat belts are available, buckle up
- 4. Do no cross in front of the bus if possible, or walk at least 10 feet ahead of the bus until you can see the bus driver and they can see you
- 5. Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before standing

STOP WHEN RED

Walkers

- 1. Walk on the sidewalk; if there is not sidewalk then walk facing traffic
- 2. Before crossing the street, stop and look left, right and left again
- 3. Never dart out in front of a parked car
- 4. Never walk while texting or talking on the phone
- 5. Parents: Practice walking to school with your child, crossing streets at crosswalks
- 6. Never walk while using headphones

Bikers

- 1. Always wear a helmet that is fitted securely
- 2. Watch for opening car doors and other hazards
- 3. Wear bright-colored clothing or reflective gear
- 4. Use hand signals when turning

Drivers

- 1. Know where school zones are located on your daily commute
- 2. If you can, reroute your commute to avoid school zones, if not obey speed limits and pay attention
- 3. Respect and follow the school crossing guards authority and obey their signals
- 4. Know the law about driving near school buses, and be prepared to stop
- 5. Follow the rules when picking up and dropping off children at school
- 6. Even when not driving in school zones, be mindful of small pedestrians when school is in session
- 7. Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks, and don't block the crosswalks
