

BE SURE YOU HAVE:

DOCUMENTATION:

W

- Boater education card
- **□** Boat license, registration
- ☐ IDs, licenses, passenger manifest
- ☐ Fishing/hunting licenses
- Local regulations

BOAT SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

- Personal Flotation Devices (PFD)s
 - Fire extinguisher, first aid kit
 - Person in Water (PIW) kit and throwable device
- ☐ Oars, anchor, bailer
- Waterproof flashlight

GOMMUNICATION/ NAVIGATION EQUIPMENT:

- Horn that can emit 4 second blast
- Cellphone, GPS, VHF radio
- Signaling devices, flares, flags, etc...
- ☐ Local water chart/map

REPAIR EQUIPMENT:

- Tools
- □ Spare parts (light bulbs, fuel filter, etc...)

CAPTAIN & CREW:

- ☐ Never operate a boat while intoxicated
- ☐ Have enough food, water, drinks, sun screen, sunglasses etc.

BE SURE YOU CHECKED/DID:

FLOAT PLAN & RESOURCES:

- Leave a float plan with a responsible party
- Let someone know where you're going, with whom, & when returning
- ☐ Know your resources: NOAA, NWS,
 Harbor Master, Coast Guard Auxiliary

VESSEL CONDITION:

- Mechanical systems
- ☐ Fluids fuel, oil, water
- □ Electrical systems
- ☐ Rigging, cables, lines, sails
- ☐ Structural hull, mast, etc...
- Air, ventilation in engine compartment
- ☐ Trailer Yes! It's part of your vessel!

VESSEL CAPACITIES:

- Range how far you can go without refueling
- ☐ Draw How much of the vessel is below the water line
- ☐ Passengers/crew how many can safely fit

VESSEL CAPABILITIES:

- Offshore
- □ Inland

WEATHER & WATER:

- Check the weather forecast
 - ☐ Get weather updates by portable radio
 - ☐ Know the tide schedule
