Thirst

Heavy Sweating

Nausea

Weakness

ACT FAST

- Move to a cooler area
- Loosen clothing
- Sip cool water
- Seek medical help if symptoms don't improve



Throbbing headache

Confusion

Dizziness

Becomes Unconscious

Body temp over 103°F

ACT FAST

GALL 911

- Move to a cooler area
- Loosen clothing and remove extra layers
- Cool with water or ice



Heat exhaustion can lead to heat stroke.

Heat stroke can cause death or permanent disability if emergency treatment is not given quickly.
